• Last Month Review (Doug)

- Free Fastpitch Fun Summary
 - 26 different families
 - Consider trying to make it more of a true fastpitch experience next year (using helmets, drills, etc)
- Registration Summary
 - 98 total (102 in 2022)
 - 38 lost including players who aged out to 14U
 - 14 to club ball
 - 2 changed sports
 - 3 moved out of town
 - 35 new players to the program
 - 10 of these players new in fall ball now registered for summer
 - 4 new from dome training
 - 4 from Free Fastpitch Fun
 - 2 from siblings experience
 - 1 back after taking time off from softball
 - 1 moved into our area
 - Volunteers
 - Coaches = 27 (39 in 2022)
 - Softball board interest = 4 (0 in 2022)
 - Team manager = 9 (2 in 2022)
 - Spring Dome season = 31 players registered
 - 12U = 13
 - 10U = 18
 - Recruit more 10Us?
 - Dates are different than originally advertised. Doug to send clarification

Assessments

- Review of process
 - Chad sent updated process/plan for 2023
 - Board with no further questions/concerns
 - Board members will be assigned to help on Monday 2/6/23
 - Friday 2/10 will be a run-through/prep; those helping encouraged to attend Friday to understand set up/expectations
- Team Selection Process Discussion
 - Review Proposal and vote
 - Process:
 - Players are ranked using their assessment scores
 - Top 5 players are locked into the team being selected

- Coach is allowed (only shown) to choose from player 6 through team size + 4 (16 for a team size of 12). Evaluation committee assists coach with team selection
- Caveat pitchers and catchers are allowed to 'play down' to get more playing time at their position. Determined based on not being in the next top 2 of their respective position. Player can only move down 1 team
- Board approves team
- Remaining players are moved to the top of the list with the top 5 locked and the process is repeated
- Board voted 15-0 to approve
- Will update by-laws with new approved process

• Program Philosophies

- Heidi & Chad reviewed ideas and established rough draft
- Heidi sent to board for review
 - Open for feedback from board email Heidi/Chad with feedback
 - Would like to include into the coaching interview process to know that coaches agree with our philosophy

Miscellaneous Topics

- Volunteers needed to be evaluators for Farmington 8U assessments on March 5 in AM
 - Debbie able to help Farmington
 - Apple Valley requesting help in mid-March; date unknown
- MN Softball is changing birth year protocols to be more in line with grade year (more to come)
- Coach selection process overview:
 - Anyone that applies for a head coaching position is interviewed by player development, directors (other board members may be included if applicant is a board member)
 - Coaches are ranked after interview
 - During team selections, look at pick pool and see what coaches available highest ranked coach candidate is called, proposed to the board and board votes to approve
- Waiver protocol
 - Need to establish guidelines/protocol for girls requesting waiver to move up levels
- Recruiting 8U for numbers consider late registration options
